

DESCRIPTION:

With its distinct sharp, woody odour, Virginian Cedar has been used for incense and perfumery and often used in soap fragrances. Khush Ingredients sources this essential oil from North America, where our supply partner annually declares compliance to Khush Ingredients' Sustainability and Ethical policy.

The harvest period for Virginian Cedarwood is highlighted in green below. The essential oil is steam distilled from the roots and stumps of *Juniperus virginiana*. This product is supplied in 1kg, 5kg aluminium's, 25kg FHDPE plastic, and 50kg metal drums.
