

DESCRIPTION:

With its distinct balsamic, woody odour, Atlas Cedar has been traditionally used for incense and perfumery and often used in soap fragrances. Cedarwood atlas possesses epidermic and antiseptic properties and has a lot of similarities to its close relative, Cedarwood deodara. Khush Ingredients sources this organic essential oil from Morocco, where our supply partner annually declares compliance to Khush Ingredients' Sustainability and Ethical policy.

The harvest period for Organic Cedarwood Atlas is highlighted in green below. The essential oil is steam distilled from the roots and stumps of *Cedrus atlantica*. This product is supplied in 1kg, 5kg Aluminium bottles, and 25kg FHDPE drums.
